

- 1937 NEA establishes Future Teachers of America
- 1994 Phi Delta Kappa International, a professional association for educators, acquires the organization rebranded as Future Educators of America (FEA)
- 2010 FEA joins National Coordinating Council of Career and Technical Student Organizations (NCC-CTSO)
- > 2015 Educators Rising launches, rebranded and transformed from FEA
- 2017 Educators Rising launches "Beginning to Teach" micro-credentials and EdRising Academy curriculum
- 2021 Educators Rising launches the EdRising Tutoring Solution






How to Officially Sign Up

Join at educators rising.org! Signing up takes just a few minutes.

- Teacher leaders will need to complete and upload a teacher leader form for approval.
- Upon approval (allow 1-3 business days) teacher leaders will have access to the Teacher Leader and Student Resources pages.

Student activelevel membership fee is \$10.*






Signing Up: Step by Step

- 1. Join as a Teacher Leader at educators rising org in the EdRising Membership Portal.
- 2. Ensure other teacher leaders at your school supporting the program join, as well.
- 3. Help all participating students join as student members.
- 4. You will be affiliated with your state program when you join the national organization.
- 5. Once student fees are paid, they appear in your chapter's list as Active-level members and have access to Student Resources.
- 6. Use resources found in the Teacher Leader and Student Resources section to manage your program and engage your students throughout the year.




Affiliate with your state program






