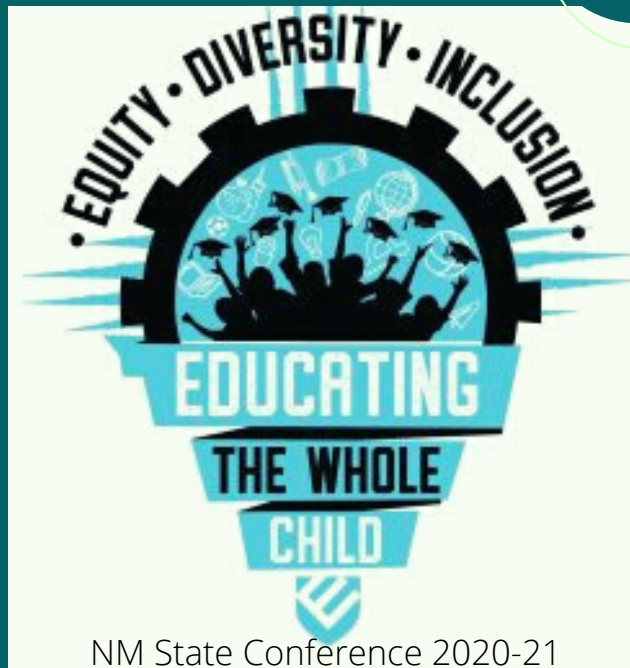


JOIN US AT OUR ANNUAL STATE CONFERENCE

REQUIREMENTS

- Complete Program of Work with Student Roster by deadline
- Pay \$10 membership fee per student

"ACTIVE" students must have their account paid by February 2, 2021. Students will not gain access to the national site until payment is received. All students who compete at state are required to be ACTIVE members with the national organization.
